## GUIDELINES

- Entries must be submitted on an 8.5x11 white paper sheet.
- Vertical orientation (portrait, see example below).
- Entries that have been wrinkled or folded won't be considered. Keep them protected (e.g., inside an envelope).
- Artwork must depict the yearbook theme: Make it happen. Haz que pase
- Only one entry per child.
- Write your full name, grade, and name of your teacher on the back of your artwork.
- Entries can be handed in to your teacher or at the front office.

## TIPS FOR a good entry

- 1. Fill the page. Think about "zooming in" to your artwork; the bigger, the better!!
- 2. Use lots of bright, bold, vibrant colours. Light colours will get "lost" once the image is scanned.
- 3. Your art will stand out best if try to outline images in black and use markers. Pencil and wax crayons may not produce enough colour.
- 4. If you are tech-savy, you can create a cover on your computer and print it.
- 5. Don't rush! You have a few weeks before the deadline. Take the time to create and submit your best work. HAVE FUN!!! 😊
